Restoration and scientific analysis

Do your art works require restoration or examination? Would you like some advice about loans or purchases?

- Expert examination and treatment of paintings and sculptures, backed where appropriate by targeted material analyses
- Material analyses in our scientific laboratory
- Advice on the care of art works and collections

Our restoration workshop and analytical laboratory use the following instruments and procedures: large-field stereo microscopy, ultraviolet light, infrared reflectography, radiography, micro X-ray fluorescence, infrared microspectroscopy, polarised light microscopy, direct mass spectrometry, gas chromatography-mass spectrometry, raman spectroscopy, preparation and microscopic examination of cross sections, scanning electron microscopy and high-performance liquid chromatography.


