Nationale Suisse and SIK-ISEA present Swiss art in the 21st century

The new catalogue of the Nationale Suisse Collection treats you to a richly varied tour through the current Swiss art scene. It offers an insight into one of the major corporate collections of contemporary Swiss art.

In collaboration with the Swiss Institute for Art Research (SIK-ISEA), the insurance group Nationale Suisse is unveiling the collection catalogue "Schweizer Kunst im 21. Jahrhundert – Die Sammlung Nationale Suisse" ("Swiss Art in the 21st Century – The Nationale Suisse Collection"). The book is to be seen as a continuation of the first volume published in 2005, which lists all the works acquired for the collection from its establishment in 1943 through to 2000.

A new chapter in the collection's history

The current catalogue lists the works acquired over the last ten years and thereby presents a new chapter in the collection's history. Since the turn of the millennium, photographs, object art and video art have broadened the collection, thus establishing a place for important contemporary movements and showcasing new media alongside classical paintings, drawings and sculptures. In addition, since 2004 Nationale Suisse has been awarding an art prize to graduates of Swiss art universities and now includes works by the winners in its collection.

The main part of the book highlights 32 selected pieces, with full-page colour illustrations and engagingly written commentaries on the works. The catalogue also contains a complete inventory of works acquired between 2001 and 2011 with short biographies, critical appraisals and bibliographical references. Texts on the collection and Nationale Suisse's commitment to art complete the publication.


